Attention Residents,

The following information is being provided to better service you. Help us reduce incinerator fees by recycling. Recycling cans are available

MONDAY <u>1st and 3rd Monday</u> Entire town.

Collection will include: <u>METALS</u>- such as posts with no concrete. White goods- such as washers, dryers, refrigerators, and air conditioners. <u>ELECTRONICS</u> including, computer products, TV's etc.

VEGETATION & WOOD- such as tree limbs cut and tied in four-foot lengths, unpainted wood products,

<u>CONCRETE</u> – to be placed at the curb in no larger than 12" blocks. ANY POSTS THAT HAVE BEEN SET IN CONCRETE MUST BE REMOVED FROM CONCRETE PRIOR TO PLACING AT CURB

During the summer months we will collect vegetation, bushes, tree limbs and unpainted non pressure treated wood every Monday. This will be done <u>May through August.</u>

TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION WILL COMMENCE AS FOLLOWS

MONDAY <u>East side of town only</u> Regular household trash, grass clippings.

THURSDAYWest sidetrash & recycling east & westside

Recycling will include – Junk mail, newspapers, cardboard, magazines, Plastic bottles, aluminum and steel cans, glass containers.

THURSDAYWest side of town onlyRegular house hold trash, grass clippings.Grass clippings placed in cans not to exceed 50 pounds.

Please notice,

Any painted and or stained wood should be placed at the curb on your regular trash day.

<u>All items will be collected from the curb line and should be placed no earlier than 4:00pm on the day</u> before your scheduled day. All emptied containers should be removed from the curb line 6:00pm the day of collections.

CLOTHING COLLECTION

Donation boxes are located at C&L Machine on Broadway & Brooklawn Community Center located on 2^{nd} street.

TRASH and **RECYCLABLE** materials mixed together <u>WILL NOT</u> be collected until separated. It will then be picked up on the next scheduled day.

The landfill or the incinerator will not accept **ROOF SHINGLES** <u>OR TIRES</u>. Therefore, it will be the responsibility of the contractor or the homeowner to dispose of them properly.

3YD DUMPSTERS

Dumpsters are available for residential use. <u>Not for a hired contractor.</u> Items allowed in our dumpsters are: Household cleanouts. <u>No construction materials allowed</u>.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN DUMPSTERS -- Metals, concrete, Roofing materials, furniture, electronics or any large articles.
