

November 2021 Press Releases:

11/1/21- Officers responded to the Dollar Tree for a report of shoplifting. Officers located the suspect in the AT&T lot. Alicia Michelle Hamilton, 35, of Camden was found to have shoplifted from the Dollar Tree, Rite Aid, and Shoprite. Hamilton was placed under arrest and charged with 3 counts shoplifting, she was released on a summons.

11/1/21- Officers responded to the area of 600 block of New Broadway for a report of vandalism. Two vehicles were located with spray paint on them. Anyone with any information regarding this incident contact Brooklawn Police.
