BOROUGH OF BROOKLAWN PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT WASTE COLLECTION - 2025 UPDATE

Dear Residents,

This information has been prepared for your convenience in understanding Brooklawn's trash and recycling regulations. Help reduce incinerator fees by recycling. Recycling cans are available. Should you have any questions, please feel free to call the Public Works office at 856-456-7785, Monday through Friday, 8:00am to 3:00pm. We hope this information will be useful to you. Thank you for your cooperation.

WASTE COLLECTION WILL COMMENCE AS FOLLOWS

THURSDAY

Entire Town: Trash & Recycling Collection

- O Items to be Recycled: Newspapers, magazines, telephone books, corrugated, cardboard cereal boxes, plastics (soda bottles, household detergents, water/milk containers, etc.), glass bottles and jars (all colors). Tin, aluminum, & bi-metallic cans (items rinsed of food products and caps removed). See lid of containers for acceptable items.
 - **NO PLASTIC BAGS Any size/color**
 - ** NO SHREDDED PAPER**
 - ** NO PIZZA BOX'S Oily contaminates **
- Items to be Trashed: Regular household waste, large articles such as furniture, any painted/stained wood, grass clippings, mulch, dried out latex paint
 - Leaves from <u>January to mid-October</u>: placed in cans or bags
- 1st/3rd MONDAY

Entire Town: Special Waste Collection

1st and 3rd Mondays of the Month - Excluding observed Holidays

- Concrete/Bricks: to be placed at the curb, chunks/containers not to exceed 50 lbs.
 - Any posts that have been set in concrete must be removed from concrete prior to placing at curb.
- o Metals: such as posts without concrete, pipes, etc.
- o White Goods: such as washers/dryers, refrigerators, air conditioners.
- o **Electronics:** such as computer products, TV's etc.
- o **Batteries & Tires:** cars and trucks only, not to exceed 4 tires.
- Vegetation/Brush & Wood: such as tree limbs cut and tied in four-foot lengths, unpainted wood products from October through April.
- SEASONAL
- Entire Town:
 - Vegetation/Brush & Wood: vegetation, bushes, tree limbs and unpainted non pressure treated wood will be collected every Monday from May through September.
 - Leaves: can be raked to the curb from <u>mid-October through</u>
 <u>December.</u> Please call 856-456-7785 for the current pick-up schedule.
 - **Spring Clean Up:** leaves can be raked to the curb for 1 week as designated by DPW. Please call for the current schedule.

All items will be collected from the curb line and should be placed no earlier than 4:00pm on the evening before your scheduled collection day. Cans not out by 7:00am on collection day may not be collected. All emptied containers should be removed from the curb line by 7:00pm the day of collections.

NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- Trash mixed with recyclable materials <u>will not</u> be collected until separated. It will then be picked up on the next regularly scheduled day.
- Recycling cans being used as trash cans will not be collected.
- Waste containers and loose waste should not exceed the 50 pound weight limit.
- Homeowners should recycle their grass clippings by using them around trees, plants and bushes for mulch or leave on lawn or can be disposed in regular trash.
- Do not rake leaves onto/within 10 ft of a storm drain or blow grass clippings into the street. This violates the Federal Storm Water regulations that imposes fines for violations.
- Roof shingles and dirt are not accepted by the landfill or incinerator. Homeowner/contractor must dispose of properly.
- Collections may be interrupted by observed holidays.

Clothing/Textile Recycling Program

 Donation boxes are located at C&L Machine on Broadway and Brooklawn Community Center located on Second St.

3 YARD DUMPSTERS

- Items Allowed in Dumpsters: Household cleanouts.
- <u>Items NOT Allowed in Dumpsters:</u> Metals, concrete, roofing materials, furniture, electronics, hazardous materials, construction materials or any large articles.
- Dumpsters are available for residential use. **Not for a hired contractor.**
 - Please call 856-456-7785 to obtain a dumpster. Dumpsters are awarded based on a first-come first-serve waitlist system. Dumpsters will be delivered on Thursdays and rotated on the following Thursday.

Household Hazardous Waste Collection

Hazardous waste is collected by the county. Please call the Office of Recycling at 856-858-5241 for event dates and information. Event information can also be found online at www.camdencounty.com. Materials accepted for disposal at various Camden County waste complexes throughout the year:

Snow Removal:

- Use driveways and refrain from parking in the alleys. If a vehicle is blocking an alley or street, we may be unable to plow the area.
- Refrain from clearing driveway aprons until Public Works has cleared the street.
- Do not blow or shovel snow into the street.

<u>HOLIDAYS:</u> When a holiday falls on a Monday, there will be <u>no collection</u> of vegetative waste, metal, concrete, leaves, etc. for that week. Please see the below chart for the dates Public Works will observe holidays in 2025. **Public Works' holidays may be observed on a different day than Borough offices.
