

Notice of Pending Bond Ordinance and Summary.

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Brooklawn, in the County of Camden, State of New Jersey, on August 17, 2026. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the Borough Council to be held at the Brooklawn Borough Municipal Building, 301 Christiana Street, Brooklawn, New Jersey on September 21, 2026 at 6:30 o'clock PM. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Borough Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: **BOND ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COMPLETION OF VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND RELATED INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE BOROUGH OF BROOKLAWN, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$100,000 THEREFOR; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OR BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE BOROUGH OF BROOKLAWN, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, NEW JERSEY, IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF UP TO \$95,000; MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS AND COVENANTS; AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN RELATED ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE FOREGOING**
